THE PROGRAM

Once you have taken a beginner course the next step in your education is to get onto a river and learn how to apply what you have learned. This is a 3-hour on-stream course that takes place on local streams and rivers where we teach you what you need to know in order to increase your chances of catching fish.

WHAT YOU LEARN

If you learn the basics you will catch fish - and this course will help you get there! Once you get comfortable with your casting and line control you should get some coaching on how to survey a river, where fish will lay in a stream, presenting a fly on moving water, how to drift a fly, and how to properly mend a fly line. Our friendly and knowledgeable instructors teach you how to properly fly fish a river and because this 3-hour course is confined to a maximum of 3 students you get the attention you need.

WHAT TO BRING

Students must have a valid Ontario fishing license and appropriate clothing for the day. All necessary gear is provided by WILSON'S.
